
## Early Postmarks of Latin America

## NICARAGUA (Period 1862-1882)

For several reasons, this country provides one of the most interesting ranges of postmarks to be found on Central American stamps. Though not as extensive as some other countries it has a unique set of 13 cancellations all its own. These can form almost a collection in themselves as they occur on all the horizontal stamps and continue during the life of the 1882 issue:—

The 1 S cancellation is certainly the most difficult to find, followed by Nos. 10, 11, 12, and whilst the remainder off cover can be bought for a few shillings each several, including 6 M, on complete cover sold for over £100 each at auction recently.

Before these cancellations were withdrawn, the "Town in Circle" Type (Figs. 8–11) came into simultaneous use,
